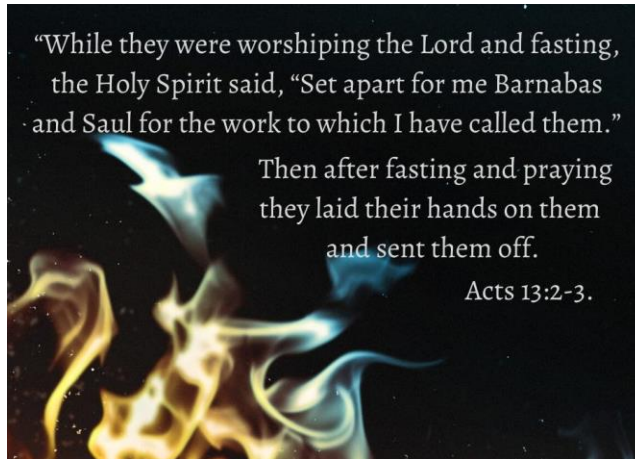

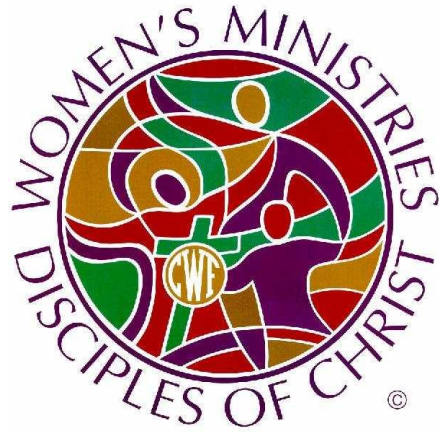


These flamingos will nest in your yard for @ 2 days.
